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It is with profound gratitude to the God Almighty for His blessings and grace bestowed upon the Campion School during the past one year; we are hereby presenting the report of all activities and achievement undertaken during the academic year 2023-24.

Academic Achievements

The students of Campion School showcased a remarkable execution of hard work with laudable 100% result. We presented 133 students for SSCE class XII Board examination and 107 students secured distinction and 18 students bagged A1 in all subjects. The school toppers are Master Flemin P Daniel with 96.8% in Science Stream and Kumari Stiffany Antony with 95.6% in Commerce Stream and Kumari Rozanne Sober with 93.4% in humanities stream.

We presented 106 students for **AISSE class X examination** and 78 students secured distinction and 5 students secured A1 in all subjects. Kumari **Nimitha Disney with 97.8%** became the school topper.

Staying updated is the key to success in any field especially in the field of education. All faculty members attended a five day **orientation programme** conducted by the school management emphasising on the theme **Transform** - Changing Mindset of teachers to make them relevant for the millennial classroom. **Dr. K.V.Thomas, Director Campion School** explained the need to bring in transformation in the teaching learning process with an enthralling video presentation. **Dean & Senior Principal Dr. Leelamma Thomas** stressed on 'A Teacher's Vision' and how team work and the feeling of belonging help lead to excellence. **Mr. Benny Kurien, President of Synergy HR Solutions** stressed on the importance of Teachers becoming great Teachers. **MsBegi Margret, Senior principal Consultant, Infosys,** presented the latest CBSE pedagogical plans. **Mr. Ratheesh Kadengal, Password Publications Pvt Ltd,** enlighten the teachers on Artificial Intelligence. **Ms. Shakeela Shamsu** explained the New Education Policy (NEP) and New Curriculum Framework(NCF)

SAFAL - Learning is a continuous process. To track progress throughout the school years and not just in class X & XII, Campion School has taken an initiative to conduct a competency based Online assessment programme SAFAL (structured Assessment for Analysing Learning.) as a part of new education policy NEP 2020, for the 5th and 8th grade students.

Student Enrichment Programme

Naval Base Visit – As a part of the Navy Week Celebration, the students of class XI were taken to Naval Ship and other exciting places in naval base, Kochi on 21st November 2023. It was an honour to experience the festivities and gain deeper knowledge and appreciation about the prestigious Navy 's contribution.

SPARK – Campion Career Guidance Cell organised various career guidance programme for Classes X to XII.

Field trips were organised to reinforce experiential and rational learning for psychology and Mass Media Students to **Raksha Special School for Child Care at Mattanchery**, Cochin and **The Hindu Newsprint**.

The Live Telecast of **Pariksha Pe Charcha Exam Warriors led by Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi** to create a stress free atmosphere for youngsters to write their exams was telecast in the multimedia room.

National Youth Day was celebrated and an oath was taken in the assembly. Also a poster making competition was conducted.

World Mental Health Day was celebrated in a grand way on October 10th 2023 to raise awareness of mental health issues around the world and to mobilize efforts to support mental health.

A special Assembly on **International First Aid Day** was observed to promote awareness about the role of first aid in saving lives.

International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking was observed to strengthen action and cooperation to achieve the goal of a drug free society.

As a part of outsource activity a recreational **Picnic** was arranged for the students as all experiences result in one or the other form of learning. An interclass drama competition was organized between the classes of VI, VII & VIII on the 23rd, 24h and 25th January 2023. They enacted The Tempest, Julius Caesar and Macbeth respectively.

Class Magazine – An Inter class **Magazine competition** was held for the students of class VI – IX and XI to develop their power of thinking, creativity and imagination.

New Amenities

We have upgraded our infrastructure facilities thus achieving some of the many milestones we have set and many still to achieve.

A new **Robotic lab** was designed specifically to bring a positive impact in students by working with robots which helps students to learn about robotic concept such as sensors, motors and programming and to engage in hands on learning experiences that are both fun and educational.

A **Recording Studio** with all facilities is also set up for recording and mixing of musical performances and other sounds.

It was a landmark moment for Campion School to inaugurate our new **library** in the primary block, with the objective to promote reading culture among our primary students.

We also got equipped with a new **computer lab** in the primary section to support the primary students with the advanced technology.

A **well-equipped Gymnasium** is the latest addition to promote the physical fitness among students. This was sponsored by Campion alumni 2004 batch in loving memory of their batchmates Shri Yadhukrishnan and Mrs Durga.

Skill Training

We introduced **AI and Robotics** to bring a positive impact among students by working with robots and robotic concepts such as sensors, motors and programming. The students presented working models for the Arts and Science Exhibition.

To imbibe holistic development among students there is regular training in dance, music – vocal & instrumental, chess, skating, evening coaching for athletic, football and basketball. The students are encouraged to participate in inter school competitions.
